



## 10<sup>th</sup> ORIGINI Programme – 2010

### Participation Guidelines

MIB School of Management (Italy), together with Friuli-Venezia Giulia regional administration (Italy), several local financial institutions, the emigrants' associations of Friuli-Venezia Giulia region in the world, is promoting and organizing the tenth edition of the Origni Programme, an intensive **Entrepreneurial Development** course.

The Origni Course is aimed at the descendants of emigrants from the Friuli-Venezia Giulia region who are residents abroad. The objective of the course is to encourage a new and productive collaboration between those descendants and the Friuli-Venezia Giulia's business system (for further information please read the attached brochure or open <http://www.mib.edu/cms/data/pages/000089.aspx>).

The course has a maximum of **15 places** and applicants should be between the ages of 23 and 35. The ideal candidate profile is a young college or high school graduate with some years of work experience, who is interested in acquiring specialized management education, export or import oriented, with the aim to establish new entrepreneurial and economical relations with the companies working in Friuli-Venezia Giulia region.

Classes will be held in English. Nevertheless, several lessons of Italian language and culture will be offered to participants during the programme to help them improve their business Italian. The basic knowledge of Italian will be, however, an advantage for the applicant during selections.

MIB School of Management is located in Trieste and it is one of the most prestigious business schools in Europe, which has more than twenty years of experience in the field of management training. The quality of its courses has led to national and international recognition.

Origni Course content, starting with the analysis of the economic system in Italy and within Friuli-Venezia Giulia will mainly focus on entrepreneurship. A possible internship in a Friuli-Venezia Giulia company may allow every participant to develop a Project aimed at creating potential economic collaboration with Friuli-Venezia Giulia's corporate environment. Participants who successfully complete the course will be awarded a course certificate.

The Course will last for a period of 18 weeks from **Monday July 19<sup>th</sup> 2010** to **Saturday November 13<sup>th</sup> 2010**. Classes will be held at MIB School of Management (Palazzo del Ferdinando, Largo Caduti di Nasirya 1, Trieste, Italy).

Applications for the course, along with a Curriculum Vitæ, should be submitted by e-mail or fax to MIB School of Management no later than **April 15<sup>th</sup> 2010**. Participant selection will take place in May 2010 (details will be communicated later).

MIB School of Management guarantees successful applicants travel expenses (a return flight from their country of residence to Trieste), meals and accomodation expenses for the duration of the course.
